	As per the Complainant he sent a Calculation Sheet of interest amount to the Respondent as per order no.1 (Execution) dated 07.02.2025 of the Authority but they neither received any reply / communication after that nor they got any payment of the interest amount within the time frame as fixed by the Authority vide the earlier execution order.	
	The Respondent submitted a Calculation Sheet regarding the interest amount today at the time of hearing. But they did not comply the order of sending the same to the Complainant and other directions given by this Authority vide final order dated 07.09.2023 so his submission is not considered in this execution hearing.	
	After hearing both the parties, the Authority is of the opinion that the Respondent is not paying any heed to the order of the Authority and they are totally violating the order.	
	The Complainant was appraised at the time of hearing that the order dated 07.09.2023 may be executed either by the provision of Rule 25 of the Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Rules, 2021 by sending it to the concerned District Magistrate for recovery of the amount due as per the provisions of Bengal Public Demands Recovery Act, 1913 or it may be sent to the Principle Civil Courhaving jurisdiction to execute the same as per the provisions of Rule 26 of the said Rules.	1 1 1 t
	The Complainant consented for sending this matter for execution to the District Magistrate of the concerned District in whose jurisdiction the said property is situated, as per the provisions contained in section 40 of the Rea	

Estate (Regulation & Development) Act, 2016 read with rule 25 of the West Bengal Real Estate (Regulation & Development) Rules, 2021.

Therefore, this Authority is hereby pleased to send this matter for execution to the District Magistrate of Birbhum to execute this order as per section 40 of the Real Estate (Regulation & Development) Act, 2016 read with rule 25 of the West Bengal Real Estate (Regulation & Development) Rules, 2021. As per rule 25 of the West Bengal Real Estate (Regulation & Development) Rules, 2021, the amounts due shall be recovered by the concerned District Magistrate as arrears of land revenue and shall be recovered in the manner provided in the Bengal Public Demand Recovery Act, 1913 (Bengal Act 3 of 1913).

The Secretary, West Bengal Real Estate Regulatory Authority (WBRERA), is hereby directed to send certified copies of this execution order along with final order dated 07.09.2023 along with copy of the Complaint Petition to the District Magistrate of Birbhum, within 7 (seven) days from today, requesting him to initiate a Certificate Case under the Bengal Public Demand Recovery Act, 1913, as per this order of the Authority.

The District Magistrate Birbhum, is to execute the order dated 07.09.2023 in WBRERA/COM 000131 passed by this Authority, as per the provisions contained in rule 25 of the West Bengal Real Estate (Regulation & Development) Rules, 2021, within a month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order dated 07.09.2023 and other documents from the Secretary, WBRERA and send the compliance report to this Authority within six weeks.

It should be mentioned here that in a similar case, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in petition for Special Leave to Appeal (C) No.16908/22, has been pleased to order as follows:-

"We direct, that the Authority shall proceed to execute the order which has been passed in favor of petition expeditiously, within a month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order by the executing forum".

As the present matter is similar to that of the matter heard by the Supreme Court of India, as mentioned above, therefore, the Authority directs the District Magistrate of Birbhum, to take necessary action to execute this order within a month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with other papers and documents from this Authority.

Complainant is at liberty to pursue this matter with the office of the District Magistrate, Birbhum to get refund of the amount as per the order of the Authority.
