- He is further directed to ensure compliance of the relief sought by the complainant as enumerated above;
- d) The respondent is hereby directed to showcause why Section 63 shall not be invoked against him for non compliance of the order 1 dated 9<sup>th</sup> April 2025.

Fix after 3 (three) weeks for further hearing and order.
