18. NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st March, 2021

A. CORPORATE INFORMATION:

KIC RESOURCES LIMITED (herein after referred to as the "Company") is fully engaged in Construction and Real Estate Sector.

B. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

a) Basis of the Preparation of Financial Statements:

These Financial Statements have been prepared to comply with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in India (Indian GAAP), including the Accounting Standards notified under the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 2013. The financial statements are prepared on accrual basis under the historical cost consideration.

b)Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements requires estimates and assumptions to be made that affect the reported amount of assets and liabilities on the date of the financial statements and the reported amount of revenue and expenses during the reporting period. Difference between the actual results and estimates are recognized in the period in which the results are known / materialized.

c) Provision, Contingent Liabilities & Assets:

Provision is recognised in the accounts when there is a present obligation as a result of past event (s) and it is probable that an outflow of recourses will be required to settle the obligation and a reliable estimate can be made. Provisions are not discounted to their present value and are determined based on the best estimate required to settle the obligation at the reporting date. These estimates are reviewed at each reporting date and adjusted to reflect the current best estimate.

Contingent liabilities are disclosed unless the possibility of outflow of resources is remote.

Contingent assets are neither recognised nor disclosed in the financial statement.

d) Fixed Assets:

Fixed Assets are shown at cost less depreciation/impairment loss, if any. Cost comprises purchase price and any attributable cost of bringing asset to its working condition for its intended use.

e) Inventories :

Inventories are valued at cost or net realizable value whichever is lower.

f) Investments:

Investment are stated at cost less diminution in value.

g) Depreciation and Amortization:

Depreciation is provided on Written Down Value Method (WDV) based on useful life of the Fixed Assets as prescribed in Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013.

h) Taxes on Income:

In accordance with the Accounting Standard 22 on "Taxes on Income" issued by ICAI, deferred tax is recognized, subject to consideration of prudence, being the difference between accounting and taxable income that originate in one year are capable of reversal in subsequent year.

i) Borrowings Cost:

Borrowings costs that are attributable to the acquisition or construction of qualifying assets are capitalized as part of the cost of such assets. A qualifying asset is one that necessarily takes substantial period of time to get ready for its intended use. All other borrowing costs are charged to revenue.

j) Revenue Recognition:

All expenses and income to the extent considered payable and receivable respectively, unless otherwise stated, are accounted for on an accrual basis. Revenue is recognized to the extent that it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the Company and the revenue can be reliably measured. Revenue from sale of goods is recognized when the significant risk and rewards of ownership of the goods have passed to the buyer.
