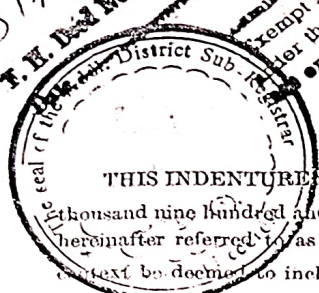

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THIS INDENTURE made this 11th day of October one thousand nine hundred and eighty one BETWEEN the GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF WEST BENGAL hereinafter referred to as the "DONOR" (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to include his successors in office) of ONE PART; AND Prasanna Das Saha Son / Wife / daughter of Late Harendra Lal Saha residing at 347 Bansdroni Chakdaha, Govt, Scheme SHRI / SMT / KM. P.S. WHEREAS after the partition of India a large number of residents of former East Pakistan crossed over and came to the territory of the State of West Bengal from time to time due to force of circumstances beyond their control.

AND whereas the Government of West Bengal (hereinafter referred to as the "Government") offered all reasonable facilities to such persons (hereinafter referred to as "Refugees") for residence in West Bengal.

AND whereas a considerable number of such people were compelled by circumstances to use vacant lands in the urban areas for homestead purposes.

AND whereas the DONEE was one of such persons who had come to use and occupy a piece of land particularly described in the schedule hereunder.

AND whereas the DONEE being a refugee displaced from East Pakistan (now Bangladesh) approached the Government of West Bengal for a plot of land for his rehabilitation.

AND whereas the Government of West Bengal with the intent to rehabilitate the Refugees from East Pakistan now Bangladesh acquired land in C.S. Dag No. *615 (P)* Mouza *Dundun* in Police Station *Rangpur Bazar* in the District of *24 Parganas* in the Urban area *C.M.C.* under the provisions of L.D.P. Act, 1948/ D.A. Act I of 1894 including the plot now in occupation of the DONEE.
