

I, DHIRENDRA NATH SEN of No.44, Ramkanto Bose Street Calcutta, do hereby revoke all former Wills and Testamentary disposition, if any, made by me and declare this to be my last Will and Testament. This Will shall come into effect after my death.

I appoint my brother Sri Jitendra Nath Sen and son-in-law Sri Ajit Kumar Ghosh, Solicitor the Executors and Trustees of this my Will. I direct my executors and trustees to pay out of estate at the first instance all my just debts funeral and sadh expenses and testamentary expenses including Estate Duty if any and all lawful and just expenses.

At present my family consists of my sons Bhupendra Nath Sen, Probir Kumar Sen and Samarendra Nath Sen, my daughter-in-law Sm. Kamala Sen widow of Tapendra Nath Sen deceased and my daughters Sm. Lachmi Sircar, Sm. Mira Ghose and Sm. Rita Basu.

Unfortunately my said son Bhupendra Sen is not a sane person. My said other two sons Probir Kumar Sen and Samarendra Nath Sen are not behaving properly and I apprehend that they would squander away the properties which may be bequeathed in their favour. Therefor I do not desire to bequeath any property in their favour.

My daughters are suitably married and their respective husbands are well placed in life. Therefore it is not necessary to make any provision for them in my Will.

My executors shall out of the income of myestate maintain my said son Bhupendra Nath Sen and as far as necessary my said widowed daughter-in-law Sm. Kamala Sen so long she would be in the family.

If after meeting the said expenses there remains any surplus income in the hands of my said executors and trustees then they in their absolute discretion shall be at liberty to spend such sum which they might think necessary for maintenance of mysaid other two sons Probir Kumar Sen and Samarendra Nath Sen if they consider that they are behaving properly.

My said executors and trustees shall be entitled to sell, charge, mortgage, exchange or otherwise deal with and dispose of all or any of the properties moveable or immoveable which I may die possessed of and invest such sum in any manner which they in their discretion may consider proper or necessary.

Apart from other immovable properties which I own I am interested in a lease-hold land at Dhappa under the Corporation of Calcutta. Upto 1950 I had an undivided interest in the said property along with my co-sharers. However the joint property was partitioned in April 1950. But the interest is burdened with the work of unloading refuse wagons at Dhappa. It is therefore absolutely necessary to carry on the said work jointly in co-ordination with other persons interested in the said lease-hold. My executors and trustees shall carry on the said work with the said other persons and shall be at liberty to enter into such an arrangement or agreement with the said other persons for successful and efficient execution of the said unloading contract as they might consider necessary.

If my said two sons Probir Kumar Sen and Samarendra marry with full approval and consent of my said executors and trustees and if they have any son or sons my said executors and trustees shall as far as may be possible maintain my said grand-sons out of the balance of the income of my estate and shall distribute the residue of my estate after the death of my said son Bhupendra Nath Sen and my daughter's-in-law Sm. Kamala Sen to my said grand-sons on their attaining majority per stirpes absolutely.

If however my said two sons Probir Kumar Sen and Samarendra Nath Sen die unmarried or marry without consent and approval of my said executors and trustees then my said executors and trustees shall after the death of my said son Bhupendra Nath Sen and my said daughter-in-law Sm. Kamala Sen ~~xxxxxx~~ distribute the residue of my estate to the male heirs of my brother Dwijendra Nath Sen and they shall be entitled to the same absolutely.

Each of my executors and trustees shall be at liberty to appoint an executor and trustee in his place who shall have all the rights and powers of the executors and trustees appointed by me under this my Will.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I Dhirendra Nath Sen have to this my last Will set my hand this 28th day of March 1962.


