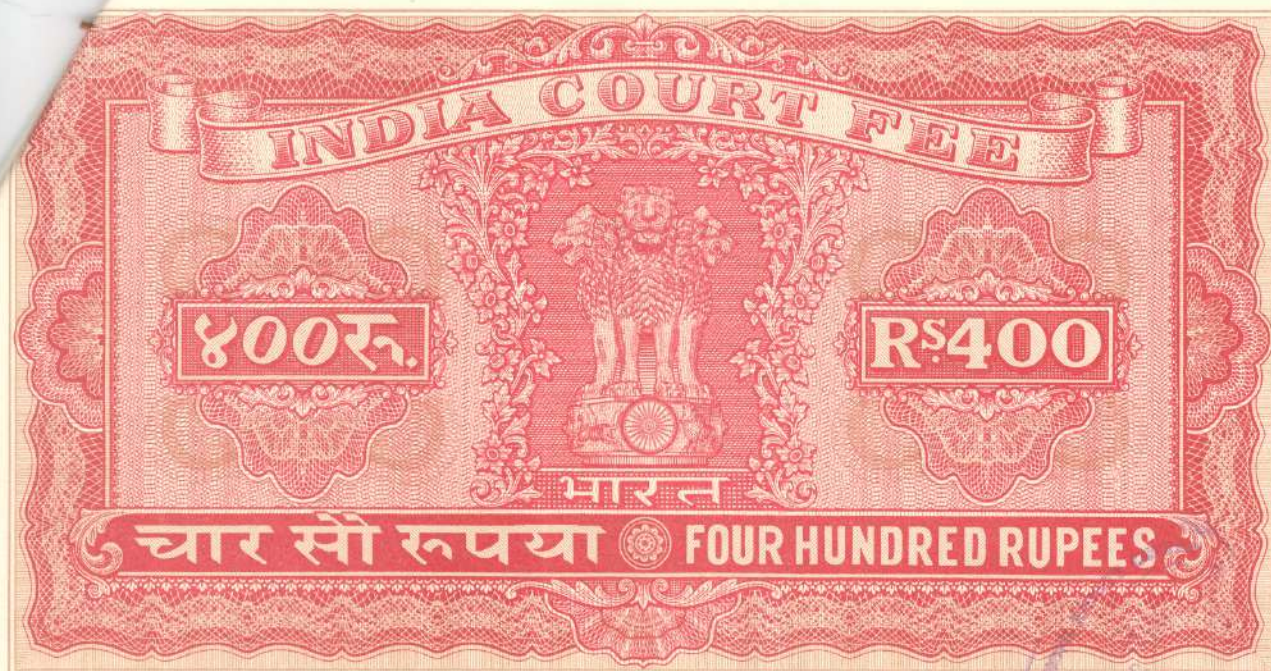

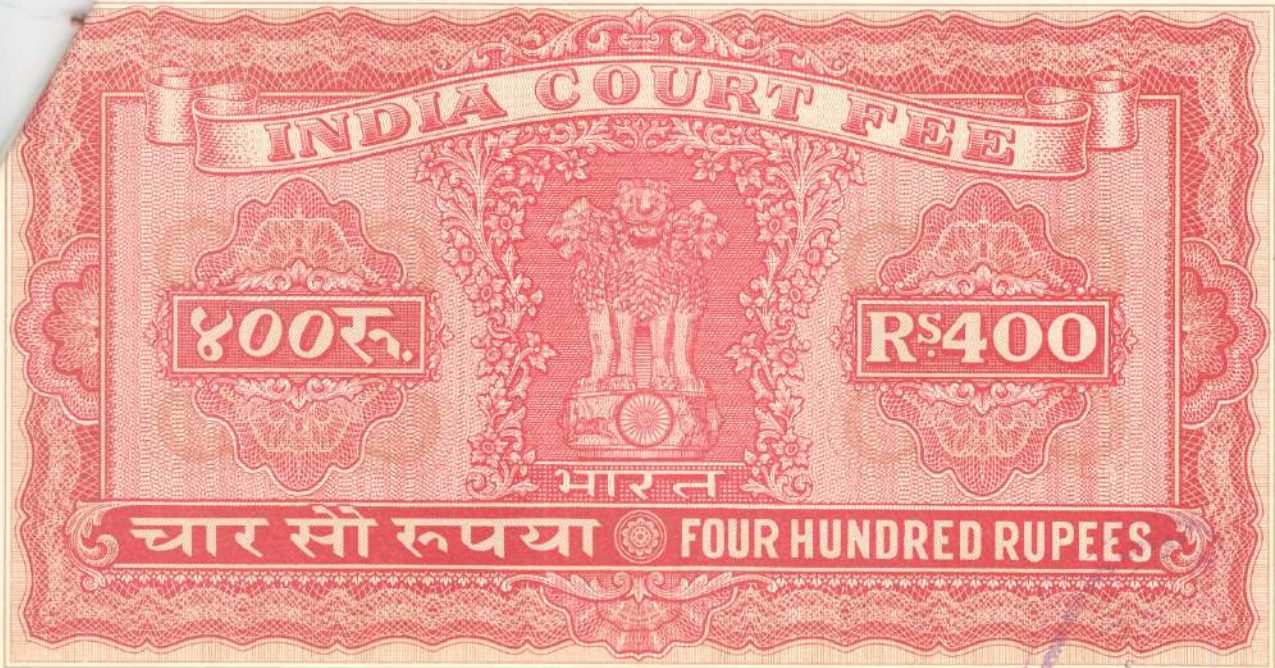

(Cal), Arun Kumar Basu B.A.L.L.B., Bijan Kumar Basu, B.Com, Biman Kumar Basu, the youngest and 4 daughters Sm. Sandha Rani Biswas, wife of Dr. Amarendra Kumar Biswas, M.B., Sm. Krishna Mitra wife of Dr. Tamendra Kumar Mitra M.B., D.G.O. (Cal), M.R.C.O.G. (Lon.), Kumari Ratna Basu, Kumari Jharna Basu and one wife ~~Sm. Pritibala Basu~~. Out of my 4 daughters the last two namely Sm. Sandha Rani Biswas and Krishna Mitra have been married and I have spent considerable money for their marriage and they are living happily and peacefully in their respective husband's house and they are well off and as such they will not get any property either movable or immovable to be left by me. My 1st 4 sons are all educated and have completed their studies and are earning. My fifth son Bejan Kumar Basu is reading the course of Chartered Accountantship and my 6th son Biman Kumar Basu is a 3rd year student of the Jadavpur Engineering College. My 3rd daughter Kumari Ratna Basu will appear in a higher Secondary Examination to be held this year and my 4th daughter is a student of Class X in the Lake Girls School. I have a house of my own at 109F, S.P. Mukherjee Road, Kalighat, Cal-26 and some other properties at Kanyanagar Vill & P.O. Bishnupur Dist. 24-Parganas and at Akalposh Vill & P.O. within P.S. Kalna, District Burdwan. Some money in banks and Life Insurance Policy and Bank Cash Certificates etc. and some furniture and other movables. My eldest son Ramendra

Ramendra Nath Basu is an Ophthalmic Surgeon. So I bequeath all my medical books and instruments for Ophthalmic practice. The executors in consultations with my other sons will settle and give the marriage of my last two unmarried daughters to suitable grooms from the money out of my estate. In this matter the decision of the executors will be final. After meeting the aforesaid expenses, costs for probate and estate duty, if any, and other expenses, if there be any surplus amount of my last money, my wife will get the same absolutely. I bequeath all my immovable properties to my aforesaid six sons absolutely subject to the right of residence of my wife and of my last two unmarried daughters until they are married in the room facing south-East on the 2nd floor of my house at 109F, S.P. Mukherjee Road, Cal-26.

The first 4 earning sons will maintain last two unmarried daughters till they are married. They will also maintain my last two sons till they earn. The last two sons will join the aforesaid 4 sons in maintaining their mother and two unmarried sisters as soon as they start earning.

I do hereby appoint Sm. Pritibala Basu, my wife and Dr. Ramendra Nath Basu and my second son Sri Malay Kumar Basu both of 109F, S.P. Mukherjee Road, Cal-26 as Executors to my Will and they will take probate of the same and they will not have to furnish any security for taking probate of the said Will.

I did not execute any Will previously and this is my last Will and Testament and it will have its effect after my death.
