It is also ordered that defendant no. 1 do pay Rs 217/9/3 p as owelty money to plaintiff no. 2 and do also pay ~~Rx 8/1x~~ Rs 61/1/6 as ~~owelty~~ owelty money to defendant no 2. It is further ordered that plaintiff no 1 do pay Rs. 90/6/9 p as owelty money to defendant no 2 Parties do get possession of the properties according to the allotments made by the commissioner in his report.

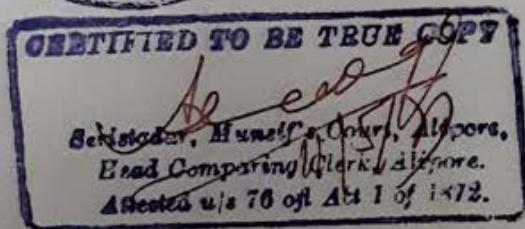

Final Report

Sir,

Having finished execution of the Commission issued to me on the suit noted above I now beg to submit herewith my final report along with a plan prepared by me and drawn to ~~the~~ scales noted thereon.

This is a partition suit. The subject-matter of the suit consists of the homestead of the parties, a tank and several gardens in Dhakuria and Haltu, P.S. Sadar Tollygunge, Dist 24- Parganas and some moveable.

The plaintiffs are two in number and the defendants are also two. The plaintiffs and defendants are brothers they have got equal shares i.e. each of them is entitled to get 1/4th in the subject matter of the suit under partition.

As agreed to only the homestead and C.S. dags nos 892, 893, 894 and 1188 are measured. As regards dags no 892, 893 and 894 they are measured together as there is no ^{line} ~~line~~ of demarcation at the locale separating one dag from the other. There remain C.S. dags nos 913 and 1126 and 1128 within mouja Dhakuria and C.S. Dag No 3605 within mouza Haltu. The C.S. map and the area noted in the khatians of the last four dags have been adopted for the purpose of this partition.

As regards valuation parties did not differ much. As regards allotment

It is agreed amongst the parties that betel-nut trees on the ~~partition~~ portion of the Common passage on the north of ~~Lot A~~ Lot A should be exclusively ~~aj~~ enjoyed by defendant no 2 without paying any value therefor and that the ~~betel~~ betel nut trees in Lot D should be allotted to Defendant no 1 without valuation. Accordingly defendants nos 1 and 2 will get the betel nut trees noted above as agreed to by the parties. They further agreed that defendant no 1 is to get large ~~day~~ or 'soap' without value and accordingly the said 'soap' is allotted to the share of defendant no 1. It is agreed that the black ~~very~~ tree on the common passage be allotted to defendant no 2 at R 4/- and accordingly the said tree is allotted to his share. The plaintiff no 2 did not take in his share any portion of the homestead. The passage shown on the homestead exclusively belongs to the plaintiff no 1 and defendants. The passage is plaintiff's ~~wide~~ 6 ft wide including the provision of a drain 12" wide. The plaintiff no 1 and defendants will construct the said passage and drain for their use and occupation.

The preliminary decree in this suit was passed on compromise. As per terms of the Compromise petition the plaintiff no 1 is to get in addition to his share a sum of Rs. 75/- from plaintiff no 2 and defendants for filling up the plot no II with earth and making improvement of the same and the plaintiff no 2 is to get in addition to his share half of the amount decreed on 22.3.38 in Mortgage suit no 295 of 1936 passed by the 1st court of Munsif at Alipore between Mammatha Nath Kundu and ^{vs} for Vs Yasin Sardar and all the costs of the suit and the balance will be divided in 4 equal shares between the plaintiffs and the defendants. This decretal amount is not yet realised and the plaintiff no 2 as per terms of the Compromise petition will realise the said amount by execution of the decree if necessary and will get the cost thereof in full. The total valuation of the subject subject matter of the suit under partition (both moveable and immovable) is Rs 24774- 13 as. Parties being four in number and their respective share being $\frac{1}{4}$th, each is entitled to property worth Rs 6193-11-3P. The not plaintiff no 1 has got property worth Rs 115-6-9P in excess of what he is entitled to in his $\frac{1}{4}$th share. The plaintiff no 2 has got property worth Rs 217-9-3P less than what he is entitled to in his $\frac{1}{4}$th share. The defendant no 1 has got property worth Rs 278-10-9p in excess and the defendant no 2 Rs 176-8-3p less than what he is entitled to in his share. To make up the shares of defendants defendant no 2 and plaintiff no 2 the defendant no 1 to pay to plaintiff no 2 Rs 217-9-3p and Rs 61-1-6p to defendant no 2 and the

and the plaintiff no 1 is to pay Rs 115-6-9 p to defendant no 2 to make up share of the latter. Out of Rs 115-6-9p payable by plaintiff no 1 to defendant no 2 the plaintiff no 1 is to set off Rs 25/- payable by defendant no 2 to plaintiff no 1. Accordingly plaintiff no 1 is to pay to defendant no 2 Rs 90-6-9p.

I have already stated that plaintiff no 2 has taken no share in the homestead. He will have to build a house on his allotment before he can quit the homestead and necessarily requires time for same. Moreover the parties being not very solvent, payment of the dowry money can not be made immediately the suit is decreed finally. Under the circumstances I recommend one year's time from the date of the signing of the final decree to the parties for making necessary adjustment in their respective allotments as per final decree and also for payment of dowry money.

The share of the plaintiff no 1 has been shown on my plan with green colour, that of defendant no 2 with gambaze colour and that of plaintiff no 1 with crimson Lake.

With these submissions I beg to close my final report.

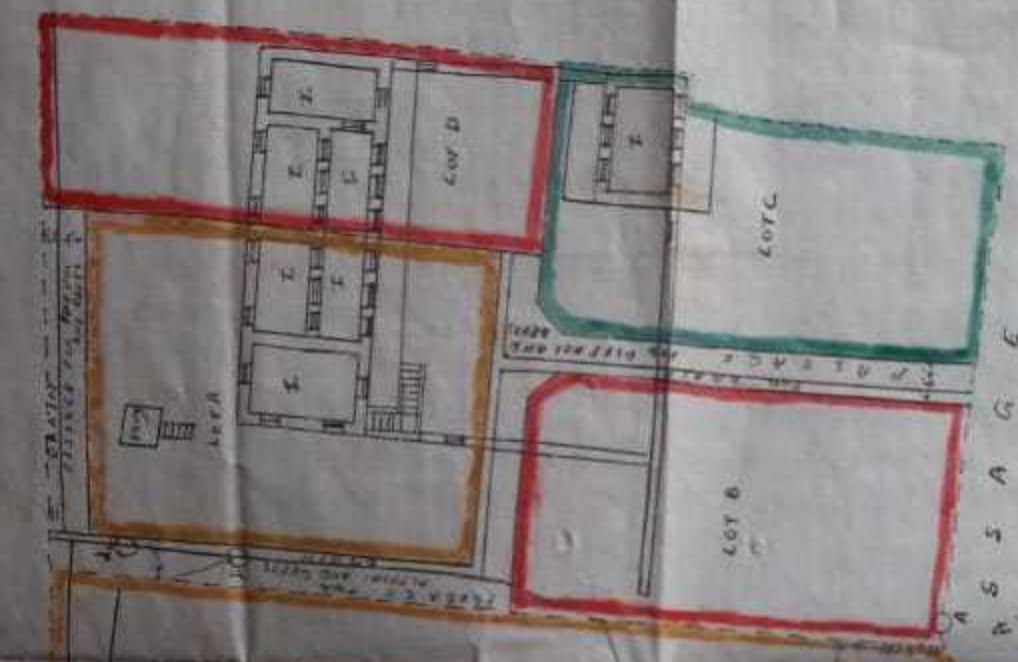
