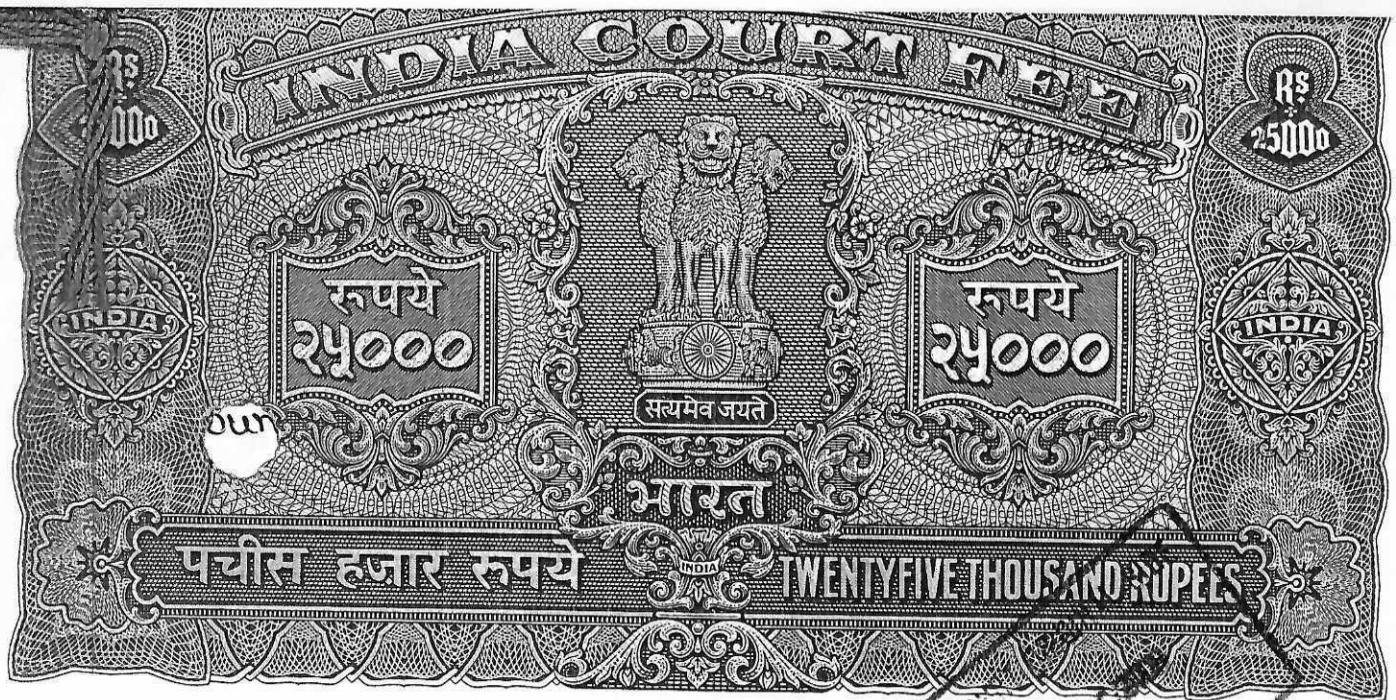

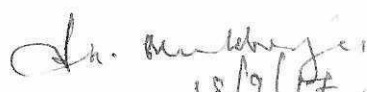
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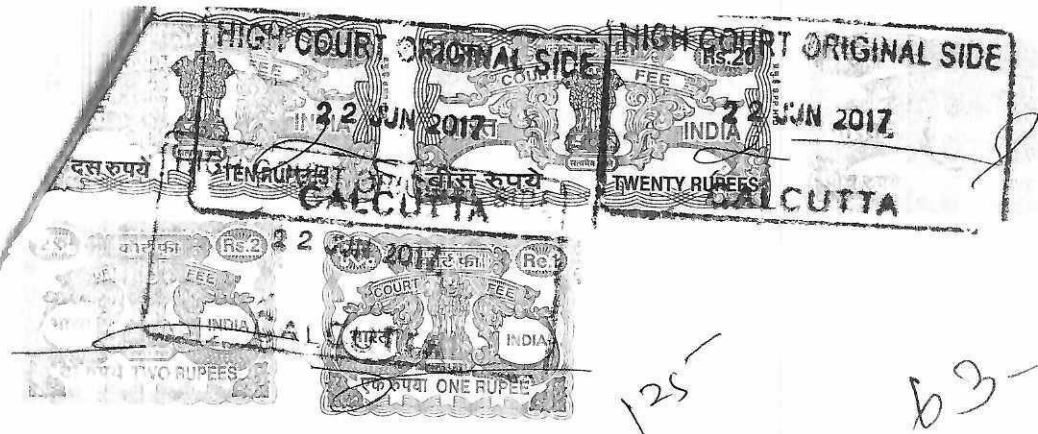

INSTRUMENT OF WILL OR FINAL TESTAMENT

I Shri Amiya Ranjan Bandopadhyay son of the Late Jitendra Nath Bandopadhyay by caste Hindu Brahmin, Occupation Business am a resident of No. 3, Khelat Babu Lane, Tala, Dist- South 24- Parganas P.S. Chitpur, Kolkata - 700037.

I am 72 years old. I have retired from my regular work. I execute this Instrument of last Will or Final Testament in respect of my properties, completely out of my own accord, in a composed state of mind without any inducement by anyone in order to fulfill my desire and thought.

This Will of mine shall be effective after my death. This alone is my last and only will. I do revoke and cancel fully any other Will or codicil, save and except this Will.

My wife Shrimati Bharati Bandopadhyay is 63 years old. My only son is Shriman Chandan Bandopadhyay.

1. I want to make it clear at the very beginning that in respect of all my shares. Unit 64, Unit Plus 1990, Unit UGS-2000, Fixed deposits, Debenture Bond etc. alongwith my name, my wife, son and Daughters' names are there as jointly or, either or survivor; as per the direction of this Will whoever will get a particular share, unit etc. he or she will have to be given the said share or shares or unit etc. by transferring the same. My wife, son

and Daughters will remain bound to render cooperation fully.

2. If in the personal properties, shares, unit, Bank Account etc. of my wife, son and Daughters anywhere my name is mentioned as jointly/either or survivor, with their names then the same by no means can be treated as a part of my property and even if such claim is made then the same will be inadmissible totally.

(Reconstruction) and new construction on all these places according to his sweet will. Chandan will be entitled to sell the adjacent land. To that none will be entitled to raise any objection. If at any time it is required to sell the said residential house then mother of Chandan will give up her right of residence provided Chandan gives a sum of rupees four lakhs to his mother by way of value for the residence. After the death of my wife all her rights of residence in this house will become extinguished, none of my two daughters or any other person whosoever will be the claimant of this house. If any such claim is made then the same will be inadmissible totally.

4. Within the four boundaries of our paternal dwelling house at No. 3, Khetat Baba Lane, I have two cottals of vacant land of my own on the western side of the northern position in the front. I give this land to my only son Chandan.

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7. I have four Life Insurance Policies in all.

(A) Policy NO. 33357053 Rs. 50,000/- No Bonus. The nomination of this policy has been done in the name of my wife Shrimati Bharati Bandopadhyay. Bharati will get the same.

(B) Policy NO. 3190773 Rs. 25,000/- with bonus. It seems that Bonus will not be less than Rs. 25,000/-. It was done in the name of my Daughter Kumkum and son Chandan while they were children. Kumkum and Chandan will get the entire sum equally.

(C) Policy NO. 33241373 Rs. 50,000/- with Bonus. Bonus will not be less than Rs. 50,000/-. This policy has been done in the name of my wife Bharati Bandopadhyay. My wife will receive this amount that is more or less.

(Fifty thousand rupees) will be given to my daughter Kumkum for her son that is my grandson Krishnendu and Rs. 50,000/- (fifty thousand rupees) will be given to my daughter-in-law Sucheta for my grand son Souranath. My two daughters Kumkum and Munia will receive the remaining sum in equal shares.

9. Whatever money I have in other Bank- the person with whom I have that money in joint name will get the absolute right of the said account.

If any Indira Vikash Patra / Krishan Vikash Patra remains at the time of my death then my son and two daughters will get the same in equal shares, that is one third share each.

10. My wife Bharati will get all my personal belongings and furniture. She will distribute it amongst my son and daughters according to her sweet will. My wife, son, two daughters, sons-in-law (daughter's husband), daughter-in-law, grandson (daughter's son), grand son (son's son) will get all my

regard and if there is any difference of opinion then arrangement will be made according to Chandan's decision.

After the probate of the Will is obtained Chandan will give $\frac{1}{3}$ rd share each to his two sisters Kumkum and Munia that is the just share receivable by them and Chandan will get $\frac{1}{3}$ rd receivable by him.

12. After my death, Income Tax, Wealth Tax etc. and all the expenses for obtaining probate of the Will and expenses for partition and distribution and the fees of the lawyers and Engineers etc. will be borne by my wife, son and two daughters, each to the extent of $\frac{1}{4}$ th share.

13. I do appoint my only son Chandan Bandopadhyay and my son-in-law Kishore Shankar Bandopadhyay, these two persons, as the executors to this my Will. After my death they will obtain probate of this Will and they will get Probate without furnishing any security.
