**AFFIDAVIT**

I, **SMT. SANDHYA DEY**, wife of Late Champak Dey, aged about 55 years, by faith- Hindu, by Occupation- Housewife, residing at P-74, Jadu Nath Mukherjee Road, Post Office: Behala, Police Station: - Behala, Kolkata - 700034, do hereby solemnly affirm and declare as follows: -

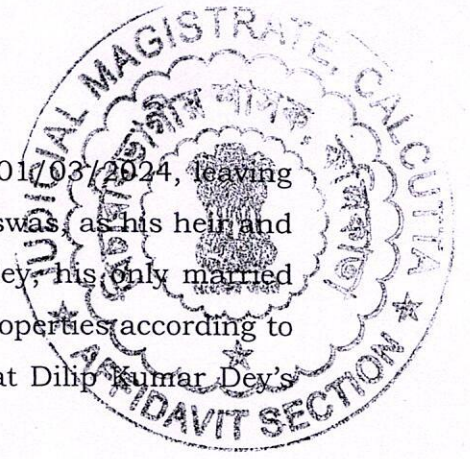
1. That **Smt. Mukul Rani Dey** is my Grand Mother-in-Law, who died intestate on 15/02/2000 leaving behind her three sons namely Sri Dipak Kumar Dey, Sri Dilip Kumar Dey and Sri Gora Chand Dey as her only legal heirs and successors and all the movable and immovable properties, as left by said Mukul Rani Dey, since deceased, have automatically devolved upon her said heirs and successors and legal representatives, according to Hindu Succession Act, 1956. And it is pertinent to mention herein that Mukul Rani Dey's husband Dharani Bhushan Dey was died prior to her death.

2. That the said Dipak Kumar Dey, died intestate on 21/04/2015, leaving behind his only son Champak Dey, since deceased and one married daughter, Smt. Chaitali Dutta Choudhury as his heirs and successors and after the demise of Dipak Kumar Dey his son and daughter inherited all his movable and immovable property according to Hindu Succession Act, 1956. It is pertinent to mention herein that Dipak Kumar Dey's wife Bithika Dey was predeceased on 28/12/2014.

3. That the said Champak Dey died intestate on 06/01/2019, leaving behind his wife namely Sandhya Dey and only son namely, Rudrack Dey as his heirs and successors and after the demise of the said Champak Dey his wife and son inherited all his moveable and immoveable properties according to Hindu Succession Act, 1956.

4. That the said Gora Chand Dey died intestate on 11/09/2012, leaving behind his wife namely Swapna Dey and only married daughter namely, Arpita Banerjee as his heirs and successors and after the demise of the said Gora Chand Dey his wife and only married daughter inherited all his moveable and immoveable properties according to Hindu Succession Act, 1956.

5. That the said Dilip Kumar Dey died intestate on 01/03/2024, leaving behind his only married daughter namely Munmun Biswas as his heir and successor and after the demise of said Dilip Kumar Dey, his only married daughter inherited all his moveable and immoveable properties according to Hindu Succession Act, 1956. Be it mentioned here that Dilip Kumar Dey's wife Anupama Dey was predeceased.



6. That accordingly my Grand Mother-in-Law **Smt. Mukul Rani Dey** died intestate leaving behind surviving her the following persons, as her only legal heirs and successors: -
