The complainant will submit the notarized affidavit to	

the Authority within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of this order, though speeds post and e mail, endorsing a copy of the same to the respondent in the same way.

The Respondent will also give their Written Response to the submission of the Complainant, within 3 weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of the complaint petition from the Complainant, after serving a copy of the affidavit to the Complainant by speed post and also by e-mail.
