	The Complainant prayed for the relief of immediate delivery of possession along with compensation for delay in delivery of possession. The Complainant also prayed that there is violation of the provision of section 14 of the WBHIRA Act, 2017 so necessary action is required to be taken against the Respondent as per WBHIRA Act and rules made thereunder.

Respondent is further directed that this is the last chance given to him to submit a written response against the complaint petition and if he fails to submit the same within the stipulated period and fails to appear on the next date of hearing, the matter shall be heard ex-parte on the next date of hearing.
